## Why are polar bears in danger?

The extinction of polar bears is a very alarming topic.

Polar bears are under constant threat because of the growing climate change, which their natural destroying habitat. The more the Arctic melts, the more affected polar bears will be because the less ice there is, the higher the water level will be, so that the maritime and transport development sources increase the use of gas and oil.

There is also unsustainable hunting by the peoples of the Arctic region for animal's skin and meat.





60% of the world's polar bears live in Canada, but they can also be found in Alaska, the United States and in Russia, Greenland and Norway. Currently, the world population of polar bears is between 20,000 and 25,000 individuals.

In fact, the decline of polar bears is 30% since 1980. Polar bears spend approximately 130 days a year on land, this will increase by 5-10 days per decade.

To reduce the extinction of polar bears, we could do several things. Firstly, restrict the use of polluting vehicles to reduce CO2 emissions from the use of fuel. We could also try to save electricity and gas and thus not contribute with the destruction of their habitat.

## The First "Extinction" and Recovery of Lear's Macaws

#### Introduction

Lear's Macaws, an species of bird from Brazil, became extinct because of illegal hunting and deforestation of their habitats, since they live in an exclusive area in the exclusive to northwest Brazil.

This bird had already been declared extinct until, through several explorations, the explorer Helmut Sick found these places in the Brazilian Caatinga where this species of Lear's macaws was found. Of course, the government had not tried until then to recover this species because they thought it was already extinct. When they discovered that some specimens of this species still existed, the Brazilian government quickly started its conservation.

However, this achievement has not been easy, and now I will explain why. To begin with, for the species to feel better under human care and reproduce more peacefully, the ideal is to replicate their original habitat as much as possible. The scientists from Loro Parque travelled to Brazil to take photos of the cliffs or caves where they had been found. They reproduced in detail the environment where these macaws were, with the textures and colour where they lived, and that was one of the many factors that made this project successful. sending the remaining macaws to loro parque in



Brazil has sent nineteen macaws, out of which eight are already in nature, and they have already managed to raise four chicks for the first time back in their habitat. This is wonderful because, soon, they will be fully reintroduced, and these amazing birds will fly again in the wild.

Finally, the grand return of the Victoria's Secret Fashion Show was a great success and brought back the brand's prestige.




## DRAKE

## TRIATHLON



Triathlon is a sport which has three disciplines: running, cycling and swimming.

They are done in order and the time you spend to change from one discipline to the other is called transition.

According to triathlete, historian and author Scott Tinley, the origin of this sport dates back to 1920-1930 in France. It was called "Les trois sports", "La Course de Débrouillards" and "La course des Touche à Tout". Since 2010, this race has been celebrated each year. Triathlon made its debut in the Olympics games in Sidney in the year 2020 with the Olympic distance. By this time, the Federation had limited the participation to 100 athletes, so 48 women and 52 men took part.

## DUATLON, AQUATLON AND TRIATHLON.

In duation, you have to run, ride a bike and then run again. There are two types of bicycles, mountain bikes and road bikes. Depending on the duation you choose, you need to use one or the other. When you use the mountain bike, the discipline you are doing is cross.

On the other hand, aquatlon consists on running, swimming and running.

Finally, in triathlon you have to swim, ride a bike and run.





## TRIATHLON



Depending on the distances, triathlon is called:

- SuperSprint: 350 meters swimming, 10km riding a bike and 2,5km running.
- Sprint: 750m swimming, 20km riding a bike and 5km running.
- Olympic: 1,5km swimming, 40km riding a bike and 10km running.
- Mid-distance: 1,9-3km swimming, 80-90km riding a bike and 20km running.
- Long-distance: 1-4km swimming, 100-200km riding a bike and 42km running.

One modality of triathlon that is very complicated and requires a lot of training and perseverance is ironman. It consists on an extreme triathlon with very long distances: 3,86 kilometers swimming in the ocean, 180 kilometers riding a bike and 42,2 kilometers running. This race has a limited time of 17 hours.


Furthermore, there is a triathlon that is done in three days because the distances are too long. It's called Ultraman and the distances are 10 kilometers swimming, 415 kilometers riding a bike and, to finish with, 85 kilometers running.

The first day, you have to swim all the kilometers and ride 145 kilometers, the second day you have to ride the 270 kilometers that are left, and the last day, you have to run 85 kilometers.



## FORMULA E





Technology is improving very quickly, so cars are better. The latest Formula E cars, called Gen3, have a power of 350 kW (470 hp) and can go up to 280 km/h. They use a braking system that allows to recharge the battery during the race.

Nowadays, electric cars have become very important in motorsport. These cars are usually used on normal roads, but they are also used in different racing competitions, like Formula E.



If technology keeps improving, electric cars will become more common in motorsport. They will push the limits of racing while helping to make the automotive industry more environmentally friendly.

The biggest challenge for electric cars in racing is the battery life. Gasoline cars can refuel very quickly, but electric cars need more time to recharge their battery. This means that the teams spend a lot of time making strategies during the race.

Electric cars are also being used in other competitions, like the Electric GT Championship and the Extreme E rally. In these races, we can observe that electric cars can be better than gasoline cars in motorsport. Some people think that electric cars will be the best option in performance.

Formula E is one of the most famous electric cars league in racing. The type of car for this race was invented in 2014. There are two main competitions: Formula 1, where cars use gasoline engines and Formula E where cars are 100% electric. The difference between those types of cars are the advanced batteries and lightweight materials, the Formula E one can go up to 280 km/h.

## IMPORTANT LEAGUES AND COMPETITIONS:




There are quite a few leagues and competitions in the world of basketball, but the most "known" are: NBA, WNBA AND FIBA:

- NBA (National Basketball Association): It is a professional basketball league that was
  established in 1946. The acronym NBA is internationally recognized and is associated
  with a standard of excellence in the sport of basketball. Initially, these acronyms
  represented a small local sports league in the United States, but over time, the NBA has
  grown to include players from around the world. This growth has broadened the
  meaning of the acronym, making it synonymous with elite basketball and international
  talent.
- WNBA (Women's National Basketball Association): The organization in question was
  founded on April 22, 1996, but officially began playing a year later. The WNBA has 12
  teams that compete in two conferences (East and West). The WNBA regular season
  begins in early May and runs through early September, and is followed by the WNBA
  playoffs that determine the league champion.
- FIBA (International Basketball Federation): is dedicated to regulating the rules of basketball worldwide, as well as holding regular competitions and events in the two disciplines, founded in 1932.

#### MOST IMPORTANT SPANISH PLAYER

The best Spanish player in history is Pau Gasol, who played basketball professionally for 20 years in the NBA, the Spanish National Team and the ACB. He played 18 seasons in the NBA, where he was twice champion, and other three seasons with FC Barcelona. With 2.13 meters tall, he played at the power forward position. He is widely considered the best Spanish player of all time, among the best Europeans to have played in the NBA and one of the most decisive FIBA players in history.

#### HISTORICAL PLAYER (NBA)



The best basketball player in the NBA world, without a doubt, was Michael Jordan, a tenacious defender, an excellent scorer and a quick and imaginative passer; but even more striking was his extraordinary ability to jump and the acrobatic maneuvers he used to dodge the opposing defense and get to the basket. He seemed to be able to remain suspended in the air for a few moments; such a faculty or "gift from heaven" -never said betterearned him the nickname of Air Jordan.
